### Our Classroom Areas

#### Creative Area

One way of encouraging children's creativity and imagination is through arts and crafts; where they can also develop self-expression. Children are given a variety of materials to choose from to create their art.



## Home

Home corner play gives the children the opportunity to act out the h o m e environment w h i l e assisting

them with their social and language skills. This area also supports both individual and cooperative play.

### Construction Area

This area enhances children's imagination as they learn to build and create different models using different construction toys like duplo, stickle bricks, soft blocks, etc.



#### Maths Area

Children are never to young to start learning math skills. Counting, sorting and even working with puzzles are all important first steps to develop a solid base to learn

math. Working with puzzles and games also enhances concentration skills and problem solving skills.

#### Sensory Area

This area provides children appropriate activities for sensory play and learning. As we talk about what they are seeing and sensing, we give them new language tools to connect

with these sensory materials and they also learn causes and effects. Their fine motor skills are also enhanced in this area.



#### Writing Area

In this area children develop important pre-literacy skills. They learn to hold pencil correctly and

imitate the writing process through pretend writing. they also develop coordination by using tracers and stencils to form specific shapes.
