Different areas of the classroom

Maths Area

In the math area children learn how to count, sort, play games and make puzzles. They also learn how take turns, improve their concentration skills and their ability to problem solve.



Writing Area

At the writing area children learn pre-writing skills including how to hold a pencil, use a scissors and imitate writing. Children also develop their coordination and fine motor skills.



Creative Area

Children learn how to use different materials, measure, spread glue and use their creative side. They also develop their hand/ eye coordination.



Home Corner

Children learn how to 'role play' in this area. They 'act out' the home environment pretending to cook, clean and feed the babies. This helps to develop both their social and language skills.



Mat Area

Children play with different toys including musical instruments, dress ups, lego and cars/trucks. They learn how to use their imagination and play alongside side each other.



Sensory Area

In this area children learn how to explore different textures, learn sensory attributes (hot, cold, Sticky, dry). It also supports fine and gross motor skills, problem solving and social interaction.
